*serve, clear, & reset for supper
- 2:30pm Free Time (approx. 2 hours)
- 4:30pm Return to Dining room
- 4:45pm Staff Supper
- 5:30pm Guest Supper Served
*serve, clear & reset for breakfast
- 8:00pm Free Time until Curfew
- 11:30pm Quiet Time
(Curfew)

SUNDAY

- 7:45am Arrive for Staff Breakfast
- 8:30am Guest Breakfast Served
*serve, clear, & reset for dinner
- 10:30am Free Time (Church)
- 11:45am Staff Dinner
- 12:30pm Guest Dinner Served
*serve, clear, & thoroughly clean
- 2:30pm Finish work for the weekend. Please check with the host/ess before leaving

Sometimes it is necessary to help set for the next group checking in.



COMMUNICATION

1. Call Tuscarora when you decide that you are interested in reserving a work weekend.
2. You will receive a letter a few months prior to your work weekend which will tell you how many workers to bring. A deposit of \$100 will be requested at that time.
3. We will call you the Monday before your weekend to confirm the exact number of people we will need you to bring.
4. Please call or E-mail by the Thursday before your weekend to let us know how many guys and girls you will be bringing and to confirm other details.

Dear Youth Group Leader,

Thank you for your interest in holding a youth group work weekend at Tuscarora Inn & Conference Center. This brochure contains some sample information to familiarize you with the program.

Tuscarora will donate \$50.00 for each worker (payment for 5 meals). A letter will be sent when you confirm a weekend for your group. A deposit of \$100 is needed to secure a date within one month. Once your group works, the deposit will be returned with your donation check.

Please give us a call if you have any questions or if you would like to reserve a work weekend for your group. Weekends book up well in advance, so please plan ahead.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

NUMBER OF WORKERS

Typically, we need between 10-15 workers. Chaperones who serve are included in that number and will also be paid. If the chaperone only supervises they will not be paid.

AGE

Please try to limit your group to those age 15 and over. By law, the minimum age allowed is 14, however, we prefer 15 and over.

LODGING

Tuscarora provides the lodging but NO linen or towels for your group. Some weekends we will not be able to get you settled into rooms until 11:00pm. Some may have to sleep on mattresses on the floor.

MEALS

Meals are provided at scheduled times. Please clean up staff tables after eating.

DISCIPLINE

You need to have one male and one female chaperone accompany the group. Chaperones are responsible for enforcing the following rules and any others that you establish. They are also responsible to help supervise in the dining room.

1. Quiet Time on grounds is at 11:00pm
Curfew (in rooms) is at 11:30pm
2. **This is very important.** No guys in girl's rooms, no girls in guy's rooms.
3. Christian music **only**. It should never be heard outside the rooms.
4. Arrive on time according to the schedule.
5. Straighten up your rooms before departing.



ACTIVITIES

You are on your own to plan any activities in the evening. You are welcome to attend Mt. Bethel Church on Sunday morning or make your own plans.

UNIFORMS

The following is the dress code required of all wait staff:

1. Black pants or skirts (knee length, NO mini skirts) and a white button down shirt or blouse.
2. Dress socks and all black shoes.
3. Hair that touches shoulders must be tied back.
4. NO body piercings with the exception of earrings for girls ONLY.

WHAT TO BRING

Sleeping Bag or bed linen
Pillow
Alarm clock (very important)
Towels
Toiletries
Uniform (as indicated)

SCHEDULE

A typical schedule is listed on the reverse side. All times are approximate and they vary with the speed of the workers. It is also possible that guests' schedules may change.
